



## Checklist for Indiana Hunter Education, Shooting Sports Education Instructor Workshop

You will need to bring a sleeping bag or sheets and blankets and a pillow. Ross Camp has beds with mattresses (rather old) but no linens. There are 6 rooms that hold 8 people each (assigned in order that registrations, with payment, are received). The overflow will be staying in barracks. Other items are suggestions.
